Minute of Meeting

1. Minute of last meeting 26th March 2007 and matters arising not covered by the agenda (*Paper 1*)

Unfortunately the minute of the last meeting was not available as the secretary unexpectedly could not attend and did not have time to print the minute off. However, David did put together the agenda with various notes at each point. Kerry agreed to prepare the minute in the secretary's absence.

2. Treasurers Report (*Paper 2*)

Helen circulated the treasurer's report to all in attendance. A balance of £522.87 was brought forward from the 23rd March 2007. Since then there has been an income of £225.76 from mini bus hires and £118.42 expenditure for insurance. This leaves a balance of £635.21. It was noted that two cheques have still to come off the balance – one for £50 for Kevan Gilchrist to cover expenses to attend the football conference in Oban and one for £10 for the licence application for the dance.

A balance of £9719.15 has been carried forward for the Mini Bus Appeal Fundraising Account from the March 2007 meeting. There has been a total income of £7082.85 since then - £19.94 interest, £6460.00 from Argyll & Bute Council, £200 donation from the White Hart Quiz team and £402.91 banked today by David (£300 from Dalintober school and £102.91 which was the Church Collection at the joint Easter Service of Dalintober, Castlehill and St Kierans Primary Schools.) Kintyre Athletics Club will be doing a fund raising event for the Minibus appeal.

3. All Weather Pitch in Campbeltown

No update received from Alan Stewart of Argyll & Bute Council's Playing Field Programme. DP will chase this up and e-mail everyone. Rory & Alistair both mentioned that Ian Fawcett needs to know a definite site by November. Would it be possible to put out a questionnaire to affiliated clubs for some feedback?

4. Mini-bus update

- Malina informed the Sports Council that the present minibus is 'ropey', but we all realise this.
- Grant applications – Will hear from the Big Lottery Fund in May.
- Bus Sponsorship – Will have to look into this after the Dance.
- Sports Council Fund Raising Events
 - a. Fundraising Dance in Conjunction with MOKRUN – 27th May 2007. We need a separate meeting for this and have decided to meet in the Burnside on Wednesday 2nd May at 8pm. Licence application will be sent away tomorrow. We also need to confirm bar staff and steward ASAP and distribute tickets. This will be done on Wednesday.
 - b. Dunaverty Golf Club Open – 30th June 2007 – Need to promote this.

5. Use of recreational facilities in Kintyre

- David P has received no update on either Meadows or Kinloch Green.
- The Rugby Club pays £7.50 for a practice session and has a block booking of 10 sessions at £25 per session. As was pointed out, there is no proper management of these parks and the Rugby Club have to do a 'sweep' of the ground to pick up cans/bottles etc on a Sunday morning before they can practice on it. Surely for that kind of money that is being charged they should not need to do this. We need to find out what they and other clubs are getting for their money. The length of the grass is also an issue. KM will try to get some answers for the next meeting.

6. Child & Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy

Need to contact Willie Young about this which David B has done already and got told it was his (Willies) job and he would see to this. We need to chase him up though and maybe suggest that we need another workshop done in Campbeltown because there has been a lot of new clubs started up over the past year.
